### **Healthy Snacks**

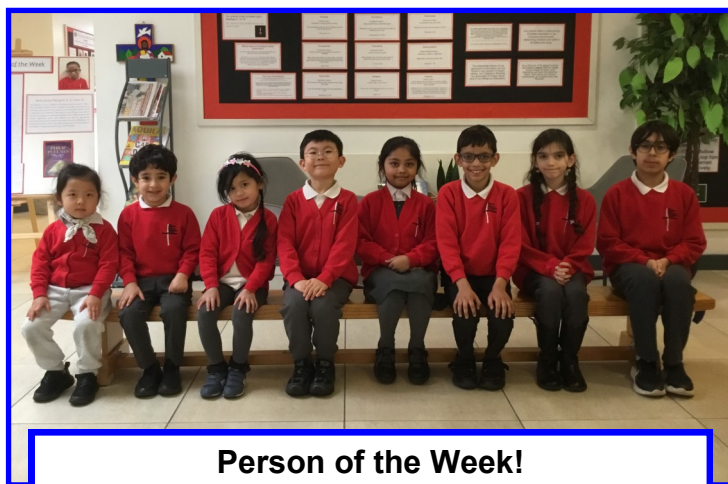
We regularly teach the children about how to have a healthy lifestyle, including how to have a healthy diet.
