Dear Parents and Carers,

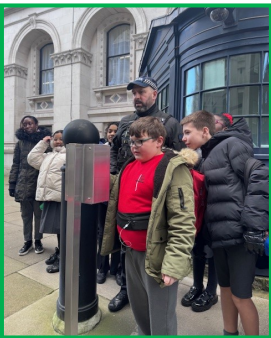

## Safer Internet Day

Tuesday 11th February was **Safer Internet Day**. The children at St George the Martyr learnt about how to keep themselves safe when online throughout the week.

The children were reminded to always tell a trusted adult if they see something online that makes them feel worried or unsure.

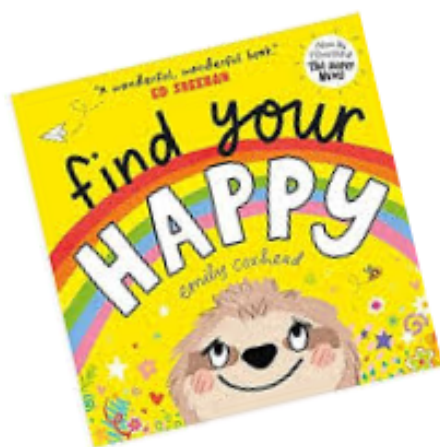
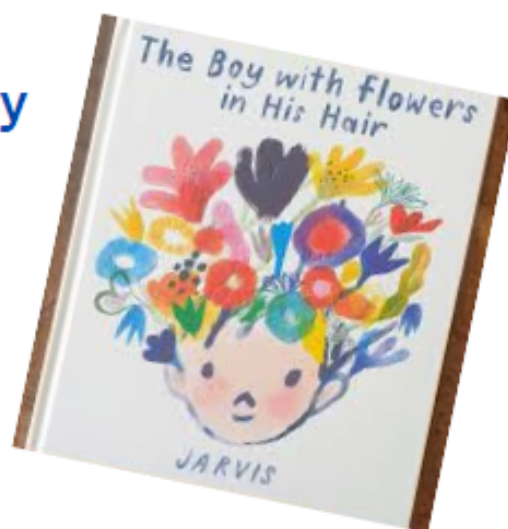
