



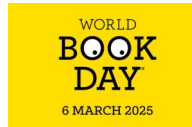
Dear Parents and Carers,

Reception had the opportunity to see a range of sea life animals, including sting rays, sharks and a variety of fish. They even had the chance to touch some shark eggs!

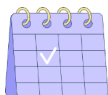
