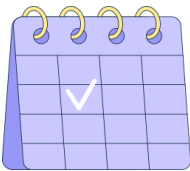

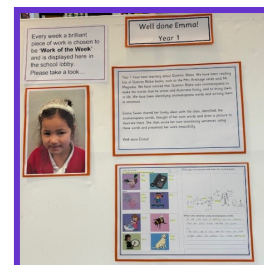
Work of the Week...
