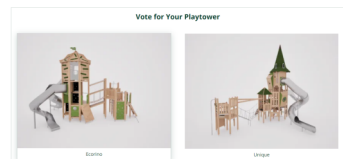


Camden Career Talk for Key Stage Two

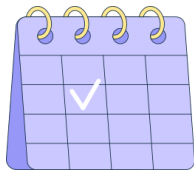

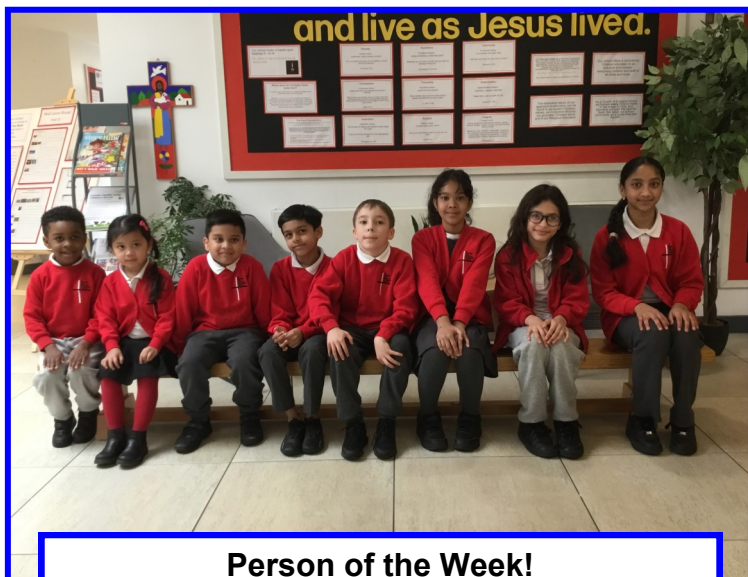
'Pay What You Can' Cinema Viewings at the Garden Cinema, Parker Street...

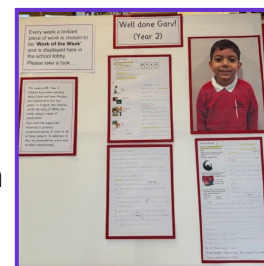
Work of the Week...
