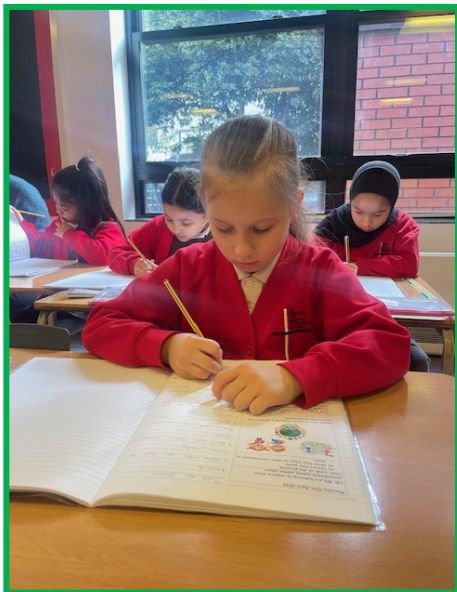
Dear Parents and Carers,

We're pleased that our partnership of schools enables us to retain our best staff and that we will continue to work with Ms Jackson.

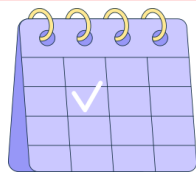

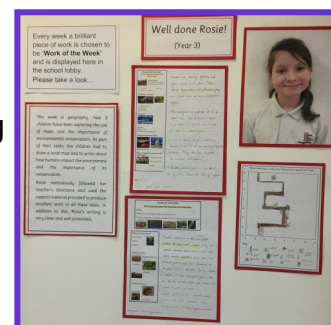


## **Work of the Week...**
