Dear Parents and Carers,

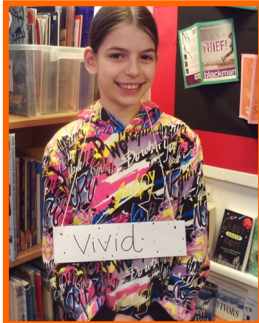
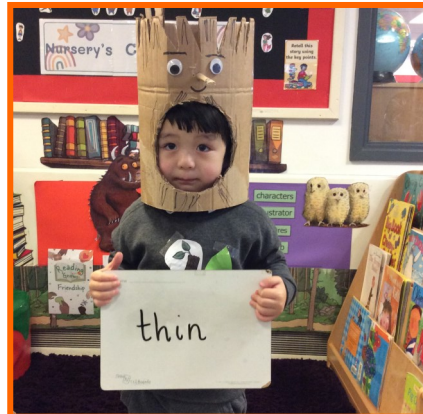

We are delighted that we have been able to run further Parents Working Alongside Children sessions this half term.

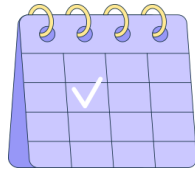

Summer term Friends of SGTM (PTA) events:

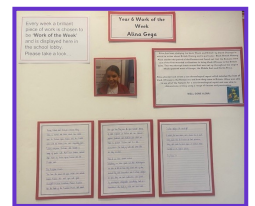
