The children visited Coram's Fields and had a chance to see some of the main sights, including the 'Little Library' and the Wildlife Garden. They had a fantastic time!

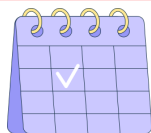

Work of the Week...



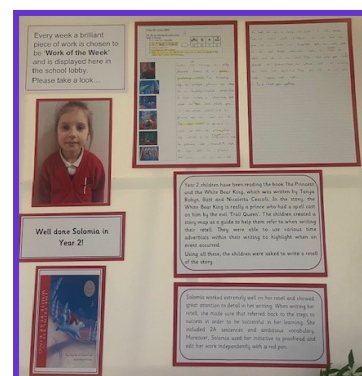
Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby.
