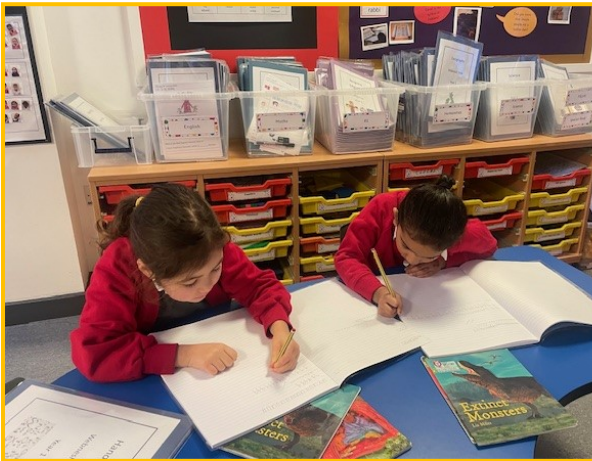
Dear Parents and Carers,

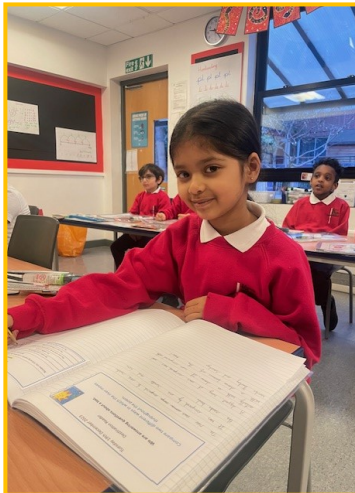

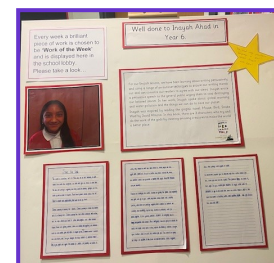
Work of the Week...
