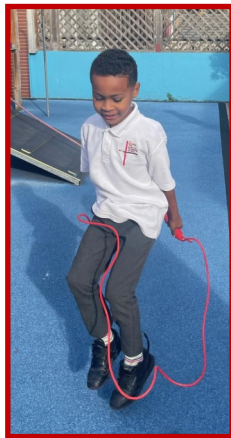


Dear Parents and Carers,

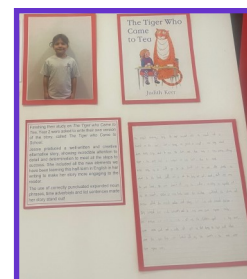


## **Work of the Week...**
