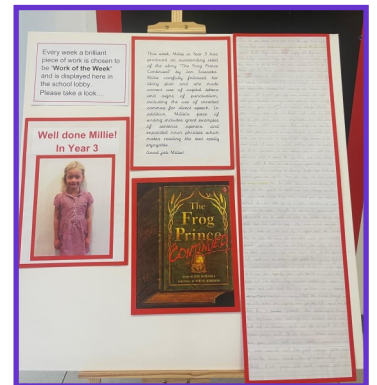


## **Work of the Week...**
