Parents Working Alongside Children sessions...

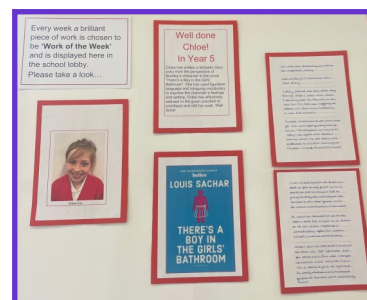
This term, we are offering parents the
