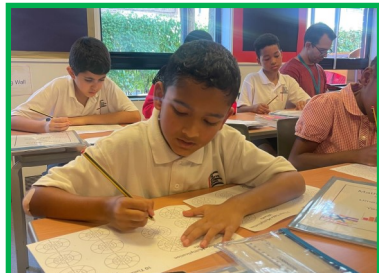
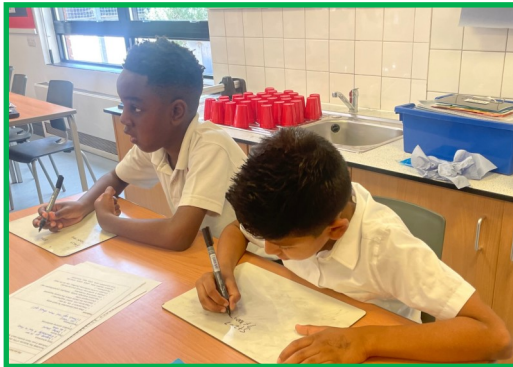
Dear Parents and Carers,

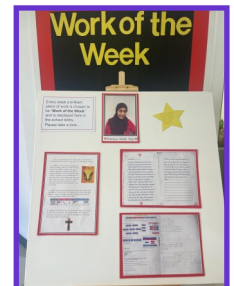
Year 6 Secondary Transfer meeting for Year 6 parents...
