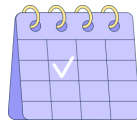

the school lobby.

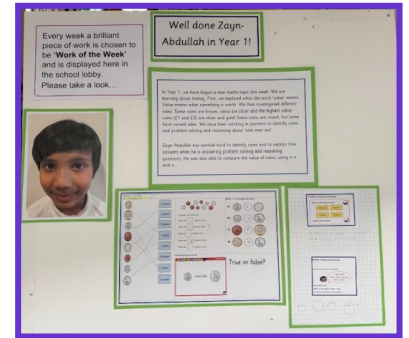
This week in Maths,

Bhoday. **We are always really pleased to meet with you and chat things through.**

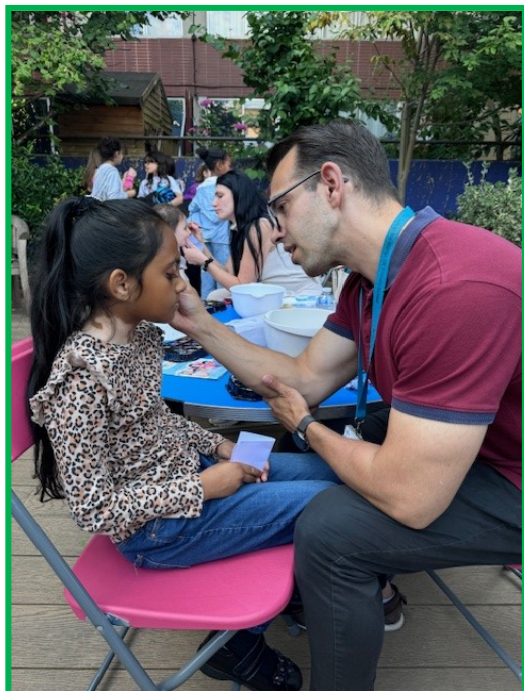
