Dear Parents and Carers,

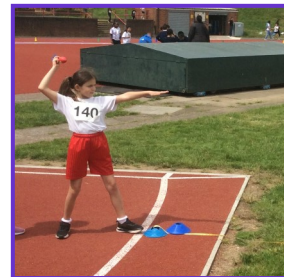

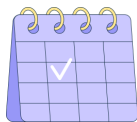

Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby.

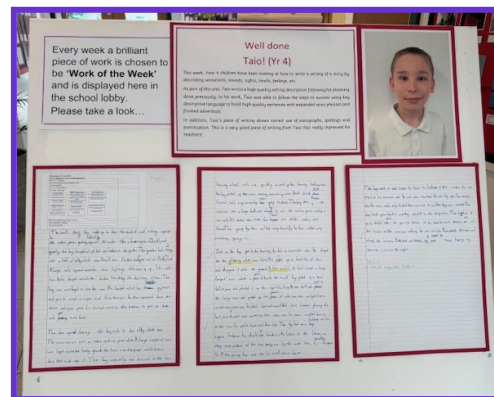
Year 4 have been learning how to write a story setting by describing sounds, smells and emotions.
