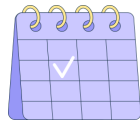

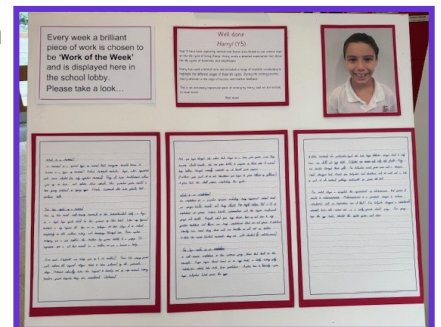
### Work of the Week...
