

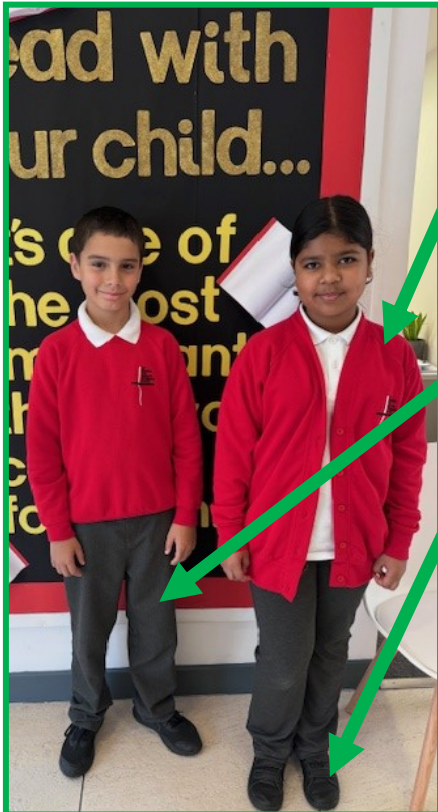


Dear Parents and Carers,

If ears are pierced, children may wear stud earrings but no hoops as we don't want any accidents where these are pulled.

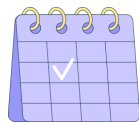
