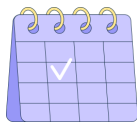

live in the Year 5 classroom for the next week.

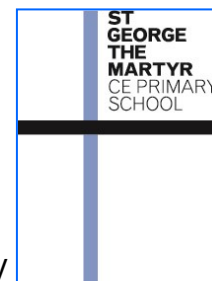

All Y6 parents are invited to attend.

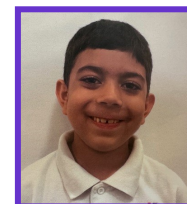
Work of the Week...
