As part of the Science curriculum, scientists from the Crick visited St George the Martyr to deliver a range of engaging workshops.

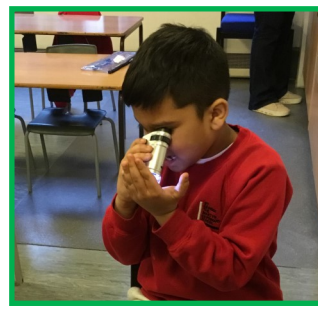
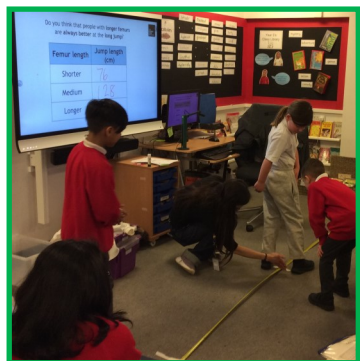
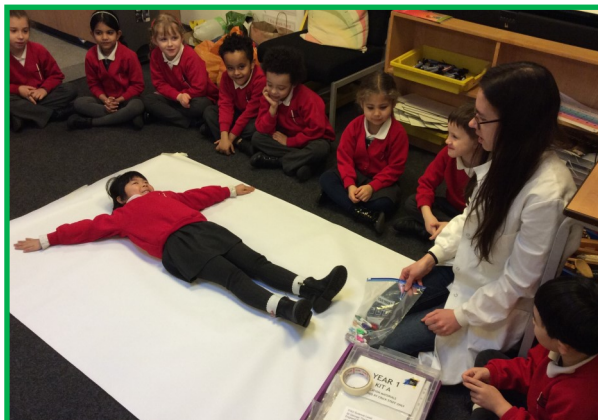
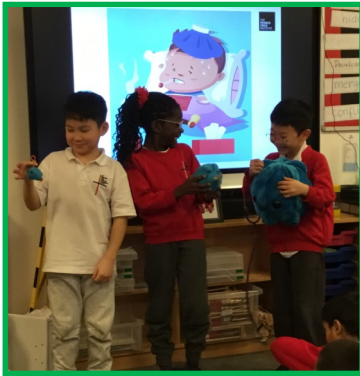
Year 1-Year 4 took part in different investigations led by Crick scientists and explored lots of great resources to deepen their understanding.

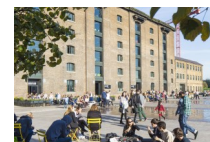
A huge congratulations to **Year 2** for having the **BEST ATTENDANCE** last week with **97%**.

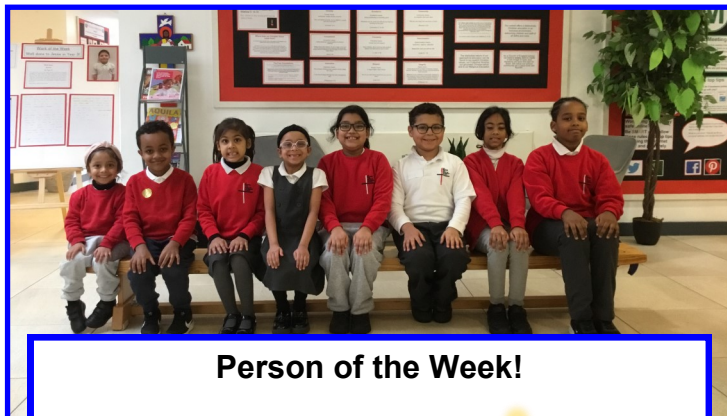
## Camden Schools Art Biennale Half Term workshops—free of charge!

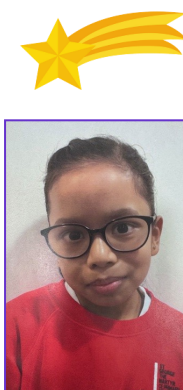
### **Work of the Week...**
