Wishing you all a restful half term break and looking forward to seeing you back at school on Monday 2nd June.

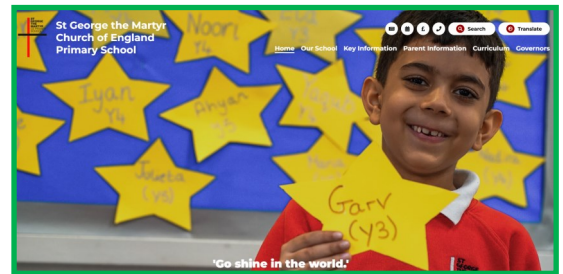

Visit to St George the Martyr Church of England Primary School - Home take a good look through.

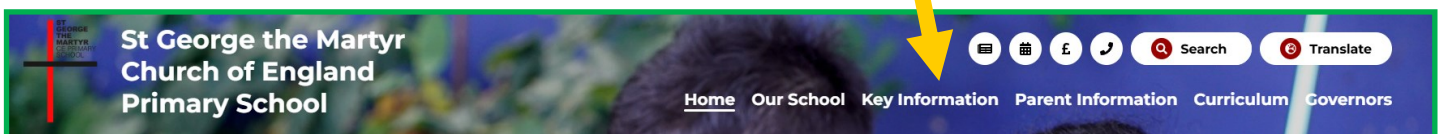

Join us in our mission to craft small changes which — like seeds—can grow into something bigger over time to make a real difference.

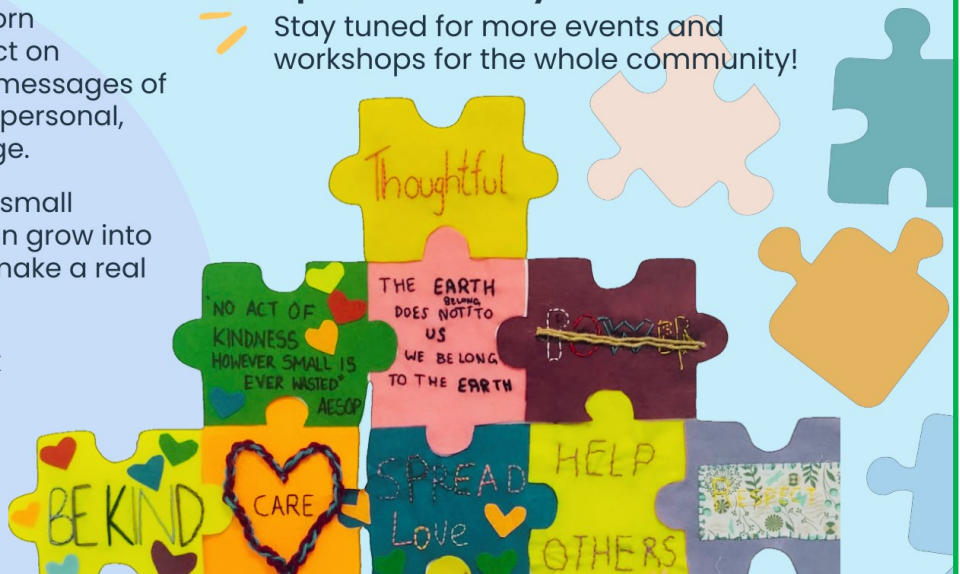
