



Dear Parents and Carers,

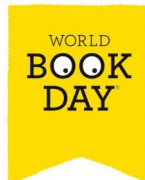
We're sending Mrs Whiteley off with our best wishes from all St George the Martyr as she finishes working this week to start her maternity leave.

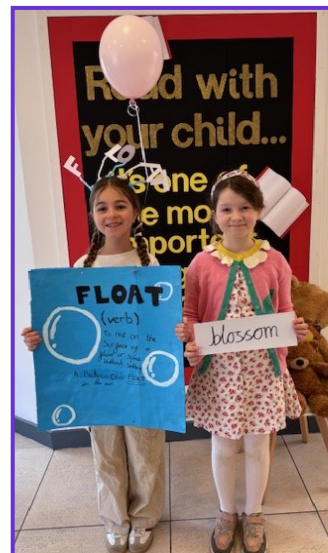
Word Aware Day

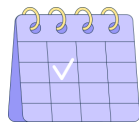
