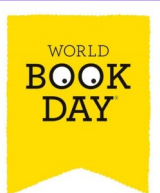
Dear Parents and Carers,

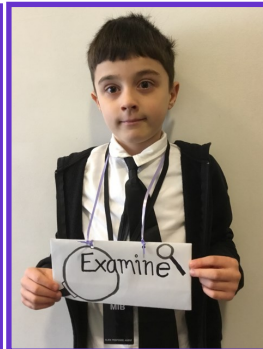

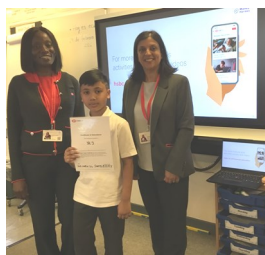
Please ask your child to tell you some of the words that they learned on this day—the more they talk about them, the more they'll remember them!

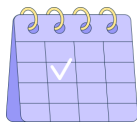
