RE - Stations of the Cross

History - Y5 trip to Charles Dickens Museum

The children learnt about the harsh conditions that children of the Victorian era would have lived through and explored artefacts in Charles Dickens home. Charles Dickens wrote many of his famous works in this house including: 'Oliver Twist.'
