Science - Nursery trip to Kentish Town farm

Nursery class visited Kentish Town farm as part of their learning about 'animals that lay eggs'. The children learnt to name some of the animals that do and don't lay eggs and had fantastic opportunities to see a range of animals, such as chickens, and goats in person. The children learnt a lot from the staff at Kentish Town farm and even had an opportunity to see the goats up close.



History - Y3 visit to the UCL Petrie Museum of Archaeology

Year 3 visited the Petrie museum of Archaeology which is on the UCL campus. We are very lucky as a school to have such fantastic opportunities for learning within such a close walk. The children examined historical objects and learnt about their use and significance. They learnt what these artefacts can tell us about the way the Egyptians lived.

Coffee Morning

Thank you to the parents that attended the coffee morning this week. The focus was on early reading and how phonics is taught at St George the Martyr. Please find some top tips that were discussed at the coffee morning below:



- Setup a daily routine for reading that stays consistent every day. This might look like reading the books sent home in your child's bookbag after school and just before bed reading a Storytime book to your child.
- Work with your child's class teacher to understand how phonics is taught and use this knowledge to support your child with their homework.
- After your child has practised their reading, ask them questions about what they have read. This will help children to develop their skills in comprehension from an early age.

Work of the Week...

Every week, a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby.

This week in writing lessons, Nursery have been learning to name egg-laying animals' and begin to use their phonics to spell these animals names.



On the Nursery trip to Kentish Town farm, Ava was able to recognise the different animals that lay eggs and produce a range of work about these animals.

Ava used her phonics to write the animals' names and then drew fantastic pictures of the animals she identified.
