School uniform

Times Table Rockstars

St George the Martyr schools uses Times Table Rockstars as one of the many ways we teach times tables. It is an excellent resource for children to develop quick recall of times tables and provides children with an engaging way to practise times tables both in and out of school independently. All children from Year 3 to Year 6 have login details for this.

We recommend all children spend 10-15 minutes daily practising their times tables at home.

For younger children, regular practice of simple addition within 10 and 20 is just as important to practise. E.g. $6+4=10$.

Please speak to your child's class teacher if you would like any support accessing Times Table Rockstars for your child.
