Tickets are limited for health and safety reasons.

In the event that the barbeque is cancelled due to heavy rain or extreme heat, no refunds will be given as food, drink and activities will have already been paid for. Instead children will have a barbeque during school time.

Children must be accompanied by an adult who is over 18. Children will not be able to come by themselves.
