Y6 Secondary Transfer

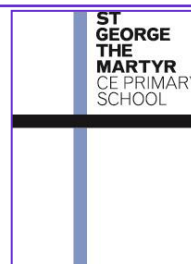
Thank you to all the parents that attended the Y6 secondary transfer meeting. A reminder that the final deadline to submit the secondary application is the 31st October.
