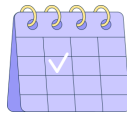

All dishes to be given to the office on the day!

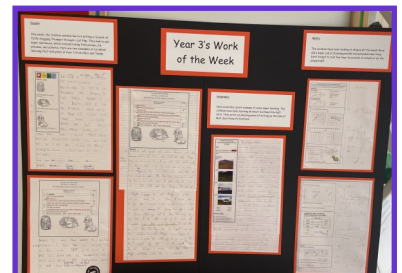


Work of the Week...
