We are delighted to be able to offer a wide range of After School Enrichment Clubs to the children at St George the Martyr for the upcoming Autumn term.

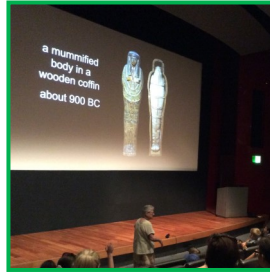

Extra donations from children in all year groups are welcome.

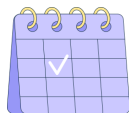

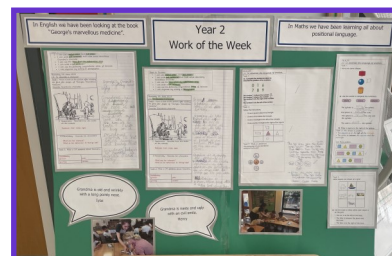
