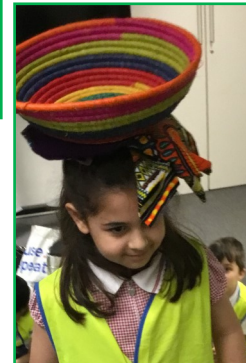
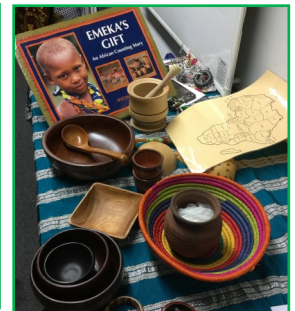

Fluoride Varnishing

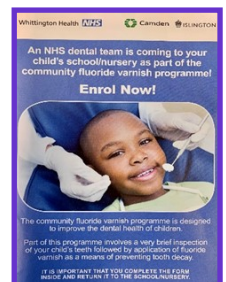
A reminder that The Whittington NHS Community Dental Fluoride varnish team will be visiting St George the Martyr on Tuesday 27th June. They will see children from Nursery - Year 2.

What is Fluoride Varnish? It is a pale-yellow gel applied to children's teeth using a small soft brush. The varnish sets quickly, has a pleasant taste and a fruity smell.

Why is Fluoride Varnish applied to teeth? Fluoride varnish provides extra protection against tooth decay when used in addition to tooth brushing with fluoride toothpaste.

Fluoride varnish is highly effective at reducing tooth decay when applied on teeth twice a year.

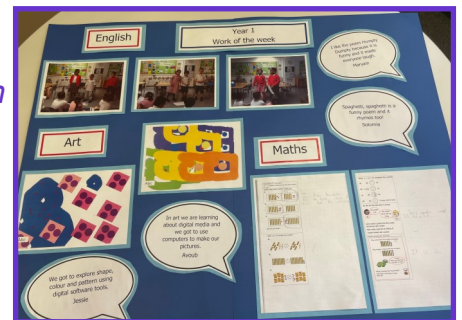
Work of the Week...

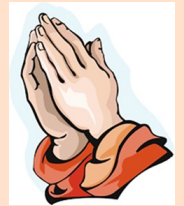
