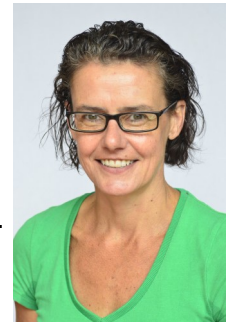
Sports Day

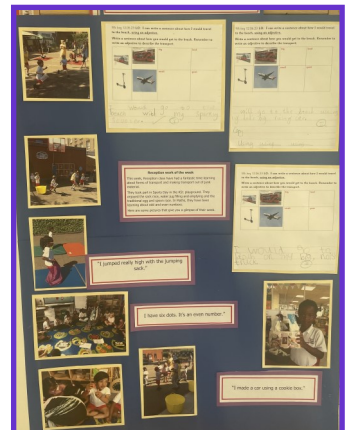

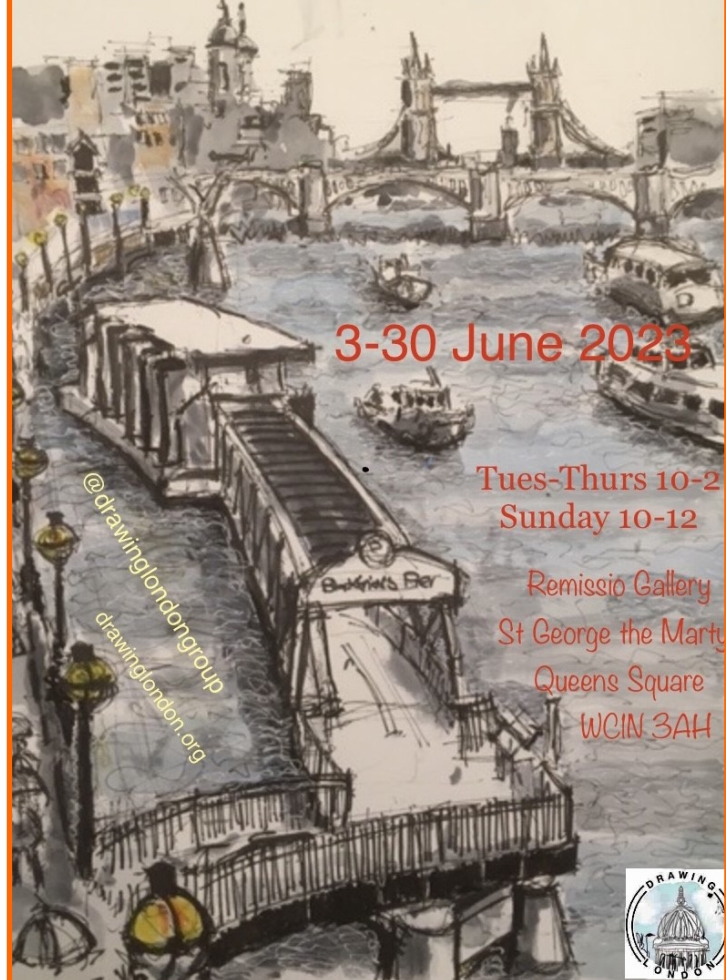
