school gates open at 8.45am.

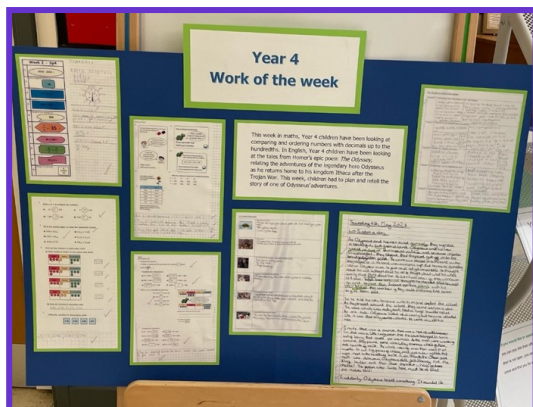
Please make sure your child is in school
