Please have a look at the '*Important dates for your diary*' on the second page of the newsletter, as we have a range of exciting visits coming up during the summer term.

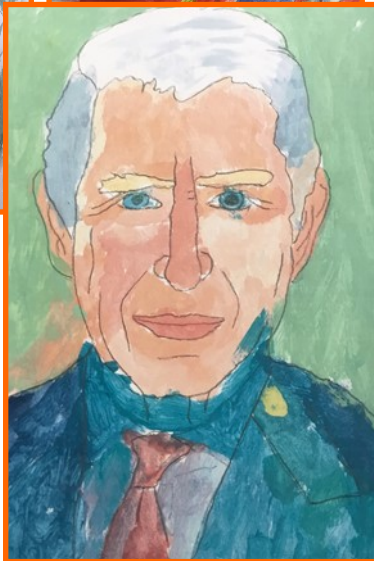
A reminder that school is closed on Monday for the Coronation Bank Holiday.

Do you have any questions about school life?

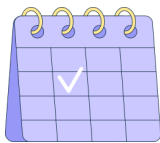
We are of course, really happy to answer any questions about school, no matter how small :)

Children must arrive on time before 9am every day so that no learning is missed – remember that the school gates open at 8.45am.

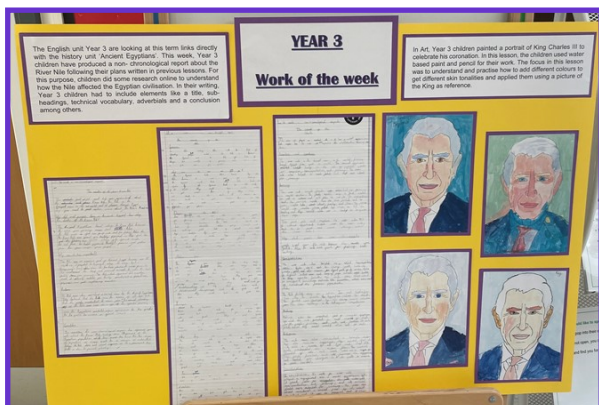
Please make sure your child is in school every single day unless they too unwell to come to school.

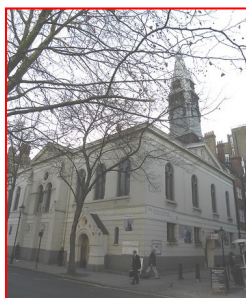
