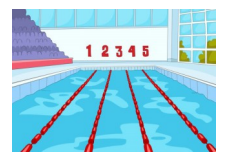
Enriching the curriculum

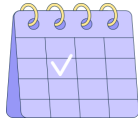

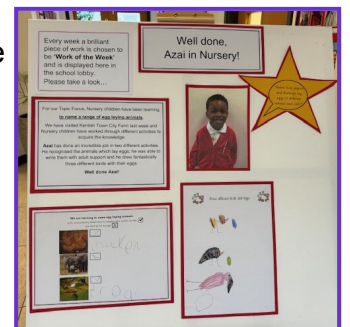
Work of the Week...

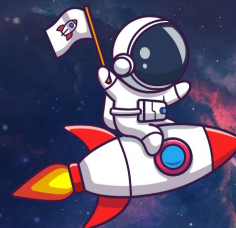
