Dear Parents and Carers,

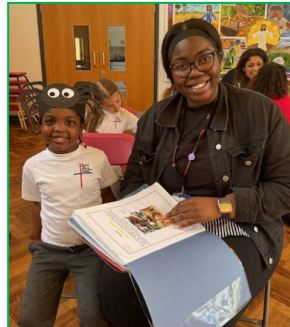

Year 4 have enjoyed these lessons immensely and we look forward to continuing to work with Platform Cricket in the future.



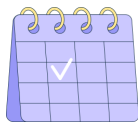

Every week a great piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby.

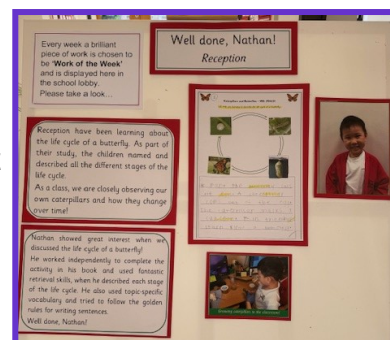


As part of Reception's topic lessons, they have been learning about the life cycle of a butterfly.
